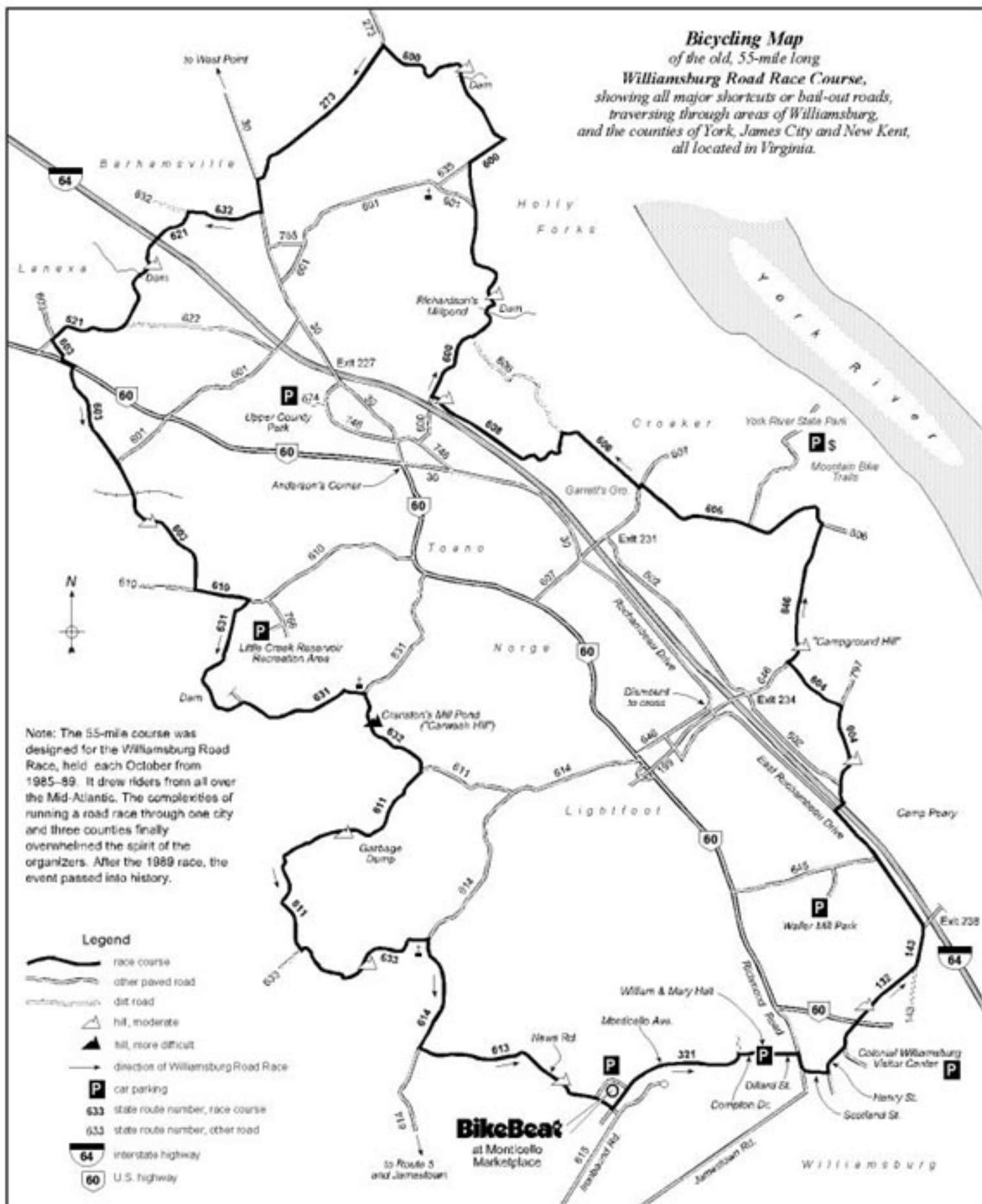


**Bicycling Map**  
of the old, 55-mile long  
**Williamsburg Road Race Course,**  
showing all major shortcuts or bail-out roads,  
traversing through areas of Williamsburg,  
and the counties of York, James City and New Kent,  
all located in Virginia.



Note: The 55-mile course was designed for the Williamsburg Road Race, held each October from 1985-89. It drew riders from all over the Mid-Atlantic. The complexities of running a road race through one city and three counties finally overwhelmed the spirit of the organizers. After the 1989 race, the event passed into history.
